1. Discussion on CBM project

- C. Romesis reported on the CBM project and the structure of the WPs as proposed by NTUA. He briefed the participants on the teleconference call that was held on 25 June with GT OEMs. He stated that GT OEMs agreed to work on WP1 Data Management but in order to develop a new tool GT users are needed.
- G. Hoefakker stated that Shell has already a CBM tool but they would like to cooperate in this project integrating the tool developed into its own tool. He stated that Shell would like to have a standard Graphical User Interface (GUI) rather than a customizable one as reported into the WP5-Tool Development.
- C. Romesis stated that the development of a customizable GUI is needed if there will be multiple GT users organisations, otherwise a standard GUI would be the optimal solution.
- G. Hoefakker proposed to set up another teleconference where he would invite also Shell IT experts who could discuss more in details the technical specifications of the tool they would like to develop. It was agreed to set up the next teleconference on 7 July 2015 at 13:00.

Prior to that C. Romesis should send a description of modeling and diagnostic tools developed by NTUA.

It was agreed to send to the interested partners an excel sheet where they could indicate their field of expertise for each WP and add on the side any IP issues they could have in cooperating with other organisations.

P. Breuhaus underlined that an involvement of GT Users should also be considered as crucial in the WP1.
