1. Discussion on CBM project

U. Simeoni opened the meeting and relayed the apologies of G. Hoefakker (Shell) and S. Muthuraman (SSE) who could not attend due to unforeseen circumstances.

C. Romesis reported on the CBM project and the structure of the WPs as proposed by NTUA.

K. Haffner stated that Alstom would be interested in cooperating on *WP1 – Data Management* and focus on the issue GT users and GT OEMs have in dealing with high resolution data which requires an increase of the storage. He underlined that data reduction is a topic of high interest for the EVI-GTI organisation and cooperation could be started with the objective to define a standard library for data management available to all the involved organisations.

K. Haffner proposed that the project partners could start working on WP1 following the guidelines presented in the Data Reduction initiative submitted to the TC4.

C. Etheridge stated that Solar Turbines would be interested in joining the WP1 and they could contribute to the CBM project by testing the tool.

A. Gullia stated that it would be of interest for the project to develop new sensors for data acquisition and he would follow up internally to check if GE Oil & Gas would like to cooperate on this topic.

It was agreed that GT Users are needed in the project consortium. U. Simeoni should follow up with ETN GT Users.
