

## A GUIDE TO THE ETN WEBSITE

ETN has developed a [website](#) to enable members to easily access and share information and improve interaction with other members.

On the public website you can find practical information on ETN, including our mission and objectives and our organisation structure. You can also find brief information on the projects ETN members are currently involved in. Information on events and courses organised by ETN, as well as external Gas Turbine events can also be found on the public website.

In the members-only section of our website, ETN members are able to access a wide range of useful information by logging-in with an individual username and password. You will be able to find information on projects, studies, new R&D initiatives and survey results as well as meeting documents or proceedings. You will have access to the ETN Members Directory, where you can find information and contact details of other members. Additional details on ETN events and members-only publications are also available.

In this User's Guide, you can find information on where to find the information you are looking for, the purpose of the different features as well as practical information on how to use the member's area.

We then encourage you to create a user account as soon as possible.


### How to create an account:

Please find below the steps to create a user account:

1. Open the ETN website: <http://www.etn-gasturbine.eu>
2. Click on: "Create a user account"



3. Fill-in the information and click on "Create account"

### Structure of the ETN website and members-only accessible pages:

Please find below a short explanation on each section of the website and a description of pages only accessible when logged-in. The list below is not exhaustive, as we are updating our website regularly throughout the year. Novelties are announced in the Monthly News Summary sent by the ETN office at the end of each month.

## **1. About ETN**

In this section you can find general information about ETN

In the 'ETN Members' section, when you click on a company name, you will access the detailed overview of this ETN members organisation, when logged-in. If you are not logged-in you will only have access to the website of the company.

## **2. Committees and Projects**

This section gives a general overview of the ETN's technical committees and the projects co-ordinated by ETN.

- IED Committee: All updates with regards to the activities of the ETN IED Committee and to the Industrial Emission Directive are published in this section.
- In the 'Projects' section, each project has a "latest development" and "documentation" tabs (only visible to ETN-member), where you can access the latest information on on-going projects and new proposed initiatives.

## **3. Events and Activities**

Information on ETN events and external gas turbine events can be found in this section. When logged-in using your individual username and password, you can access more detailed information relating to exclusive ETN events such as minutes of meetings, meeting agendas, presentations and pictures.

## **4. Publications**

When logged-in to the members-only area, ETN members can view publications including "EU Policy Briefings" or the "Monthly News Summaries", which are not available on the public website.

## **5. Membership**

Information on ETN membership aimed at potential members.

## **6. Contact**

Contact information and address to reach the ETN office in Brussels, Belgium.

## **7. Members Area**

This whole section is visible only to ETN member which have logged-in on the Members Area. This section includes:

- The ETN members contact list: Contains the contact details of one contact person per member organisation
- The member directory: It allows members to get an overview of ETN members and search for member organisations and persons which have an account on the ETN website.
