INDUSTRIAL EMISSIONS DIRECTIVE COMMITTEE

ETN's committee in charge of monitoring and reacting to the Industrial Emissions Directive and related regulations has worked on a white paper following the review of the BREF for Large Combustion Plants. This BREF - Best Available Technique (BAT) Reference Document – is a 964-page long document guiding the implementation of the Directive. The original version was published in 2006 and went through an in-depth revision last year. ETN believes that this reviewed version still leaves pending issues that need to be addressed, questioning the future of numerous gas-fired plants. Once published, the document will be sent to ETN's members, the European Commission, the industry stakeholders and the member states representations towards the EU and national regulation authorities.
