TECHNICAL COMMITTEE AND PROJECT UPDATES

Air Filtration Project: On 6 May, members of the Air Filtration Project met in Brussels to discuss the part 2, 5 and 6 of the ISO-29461 standard and the comments submitted by the Working Group's members. Peter Hall (E.ON Technologies) was elected Chair of the Air Filtration Project, with Alex Straver (Shell) and Olaf Brekke (Statoil) as co-Chairs. Peter Hall will attend, on behalf of ETN's Air Filtration WG, the next ISO/TC 142 meeting which will take place in Amsterdam on 8 June 2015.

OMSoP Project: On 11 May, City University London (OMSoP Project Coordinator) organised an OMSoP dissemination meeting and a visit to their Micro Gas Turbine test facility and laboratory in London, UK. More than 30 participants joined the meeting and the site visit and participated to the MGT meeting the following day.

Micro Gas Turbine (MGT) Project: On 12 May, following the OMSoP dissemination meeting, MGT OEMs, Universities and R&D Institutes met at City University London to explore cooperation opportunities



for MGT technology developements. More than 30 participants joined the meeting where the OEMs presented their technology and Universities presented their expertise and capabilities. Exhaust Systems Subgroup Meeting: On 26-27 May, the Exhaust Systems Subgroup members met to review the structure and comments of the Waste Heat Recovery Equipment Standard (WHRES).

TC 2: Operational and Fuel Flexibility: On 28 May, a teleconference call took place between TC 2 members on CO emission/Combustion Dynamic Prediction & Control. TC members followed-up on the AGM dicussions and additional initiatives. The minutes of the meeting with the agreed actions will be available before 12 June on the TC 2 webpage.

POLICY UPDATES

EU Emission Trading System (ETS) – Market Stability Reserve: On 6 May, Member States and European Parliament (EP) agreed to bring forward the start date of the Market Stability Reserve to 1 January 2019 which was also backed by the Environment Committee on 26 May. According to the European Commission, if the Market Stability Reserve would operate from 2019, this would raise the carbon price to an average 35 EUR/ton in the next decade (currently around 7 EUR/ton). The proposed law would create a system that automatically takes a portion of ETS allowances off the market and into the reserve if the surplus exceeds a certain threshold. In the opposite scenario, allowances could be returned to the market. The surplus of emission allowances, which has been building up in the system since 2009, is estimated at over 2 billion.

Under the proposed deal, « backloaded » allowances (900 million allowances withdrawn from the market), would be placed in the reserve. Remaining allowances unallocated by at the end of the current trading phase (2020) should also be placed in the reserve, subject to an overall review of the ETS directive, to be tabled by the European Commission later this year. It was also agreed that so-called "solidarity allowances", amounting to 10% of the annual total and allocated to certain EU member states in Central and Eastern Europe, would be exempt from the reserve until 2025. The provisional agreement will be put to a vote at the 6-9 July plenary session in Strasbourg.
