Policy Session at the EUSEW: ETN is organising a Policy Session at the European Union Sustainable Energy Week (EUSEW) entitled "*Micro Gas Turbines put a new spin on green energy production*". The EUSEW is a week-long series of sessions and exhibitions that promotes a secure energy future for Europe.
