TECHNICAL COMMITTEE AND PROJECT UPDATES

OMSoP Consortium Meeting: On 25-26 November 2015, the OMSoP project partners met in Stockholm, Sweden to discuss the latest developments of the project. The OMSOP project is making good progress and is now in the final stage of the component development and preparation phase. The final demonstration phase will start early in 2016 on the component level and in mid-2016 as a standalone system. First the receiver and the 3D printed micro gas turbine will be demonstrated individually and then shipped to Rome for ENEA to assemble the complete package with the parabolic dish before the start of the system demonstration. Parallel to this, an optimised design of the components and the system based on obtained data and techno-economic analysis is being developed for future testing and deployment.

Micro Gas Turbine (MGT) Project: Following the MGT meeting held in Brussels in October 2015, the MGT Working Group (WG) is working on drafting a description and way forward for five main MGT challenges: Fuel Flexibility, Materials, Recuperator, Efficiency and Cycle. These documents represent a core section of the MGT vision document that the WG aims to compile.

POLICY UPDATES

Energy Union: Following the publication of the "Framework Strategy for a Resilient Union" in February 2015, the European Commission (EC) published in November 2015 the first State of the Energy Union Report which shows the progress that has been made over the last nine months, identifies key action areas for 2016 and provides policy conclusions at Member State, regional and European levels. The EC has committed to present these reports annually in order to address the key issues and steer the policy debate. The EC has also published 28 factsheets (one per Member State), giving an overview of where each Member State stands today on many aspects of the five dimensions of the Energy Union. UN Climate Change Negotiations COP21: The United Nation Conference on Climate Change will take place from 30 November to 11 December 2015 in Paris, France. Currently, 176 countries representing more than 90% of global emissions have presented their contributions to the Paris Agreement. Based on the current contributions, the world would be heading for a rise of around 3°C, that is between 2.7°C and 3.5°C by the end of the century. One of the challenges of the Paris agreement will be to establish a periodic review mechanism to raise the ambition of each Party.
