ETN Annual General Meeting and Workshop (17-18 April 2012) took place in Berlin, Germany. In the morning of the 17 April, prior to the start of the AGM, there was the possibility of visiting TU Berlin's laboratory, Vattenfall's CHP plant or MTU's Overhaul facilities.

During the AGM and the Workshop presentations and discussions centered around upcoming R&D funding opportunities, discussions on future priority R&D areas and new ETN initiatives, EU policy updates and the latest developments on the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED). Moreover, ETN's new internal structure was presented, along with its new project development process and the new Project Board members. The new ETN visual identity and website were demonstrated, and there was the election of the new ETN Board 2012-2013.

Position Paper on the Importance of including Flexible and Efficient Conventional Power Generation in the Horizon 2020 R&D Programme: ETN has published a position paper, in collaboration with EPPSA, Eurelectric, EUTurbines, Eurogas, Euracoal, GERG and Marcogaz, on the Research Priorities of the upcoming Horizon 2020 EU funded R&D Programme (2014-2020). The position paper has been submitted to the European Parliament and Commission, and aims to influence the final decision on R&D priorities and funding levels. ETN's response to Industrial Emissions Directive by EU: in a joint effort by ETN, Pratt & Whitney and E.ON an opinion based on the discussion at the ETN Workshop in Berlin, Germany on the current legislative negotiations taking place, has been submitted to the LCD BREF Review Committee of the EU's Joint Research Centre. ETN Meetings and Events Attended during April 2012:

ETN Board meeting (16 April 2012): the second ETN Board meeting of 2012 was kindly hosted by Vattenfall in their Berlin offices. The main focus of this Board meeting was the budget and financing for the upcoming period, as well as the new ETN communications strategy. Moreover, the agenda and speakers of ETN's upcoming International Gas Turbine Conference were discussed, to be held 17-18 October 2012; as were the topics and

organisation of the AGM and Workshop, which took place on the following days. Minutes of the meeting will be available on the ETN website shortly. The next ETN Board meeting will take place on 10-11 July 2012 in Baden, Switzerland.

GasNaturally (23-27 April 2012): ETN attended the event in the European Parliament in Brussels, Belgium, which aimed to showcase the ability of natural gas to contribute to a low carbon economy. The event was organised by seven energy associations which promote gas in Brussels, and attended by industry, experts, NGOs and policy makers. How to Implement the EU Energy Roadmap 2050 (25 April 2012): ETN attended the event at the Bavarian Representation in Brussels, Belgium, which discussed the role of the Energy Roadmap 2050 in forming a basis on which to discuss the future energy mix of Europe, and its possible implementation. Forum of Technology – Advanced Coatings for High Temperatures (25 - 27 April 2012): ETN attended the event in Nice, Forum. The conference discussed that, as a result of the increased firing temperature and thermo cycles in future gas turbines, there is a need to push for TBC with increased performance and reliability. A need for more distinct material development rather than only adapted material from the aero sector was highlighted as well as a need to move from an experimental environment to more diagnostic based development.

Educational Programme: The Gas Turbine Short Courses, part of ETN's new educational programme, will be directed by the Department of Power & Propulsion, Cranfield University and hosted by Total in Pau, France on 4-8 June 2012.

The objective of the courses is to familiarise the participants with engine and component design and the performance of stationary gas turbines. The course content has been chosen primarily to benefit employees who are (or will be) involved in engine performance evaluation, operations and maintenance. The courses will be of particular value to practising engineers in gas turbine user industries who could benefit from an overview of the design and performance of the entire engine. Upon completion of the course, participants should emerge with an improved appreciation of gas turbines, adding extra value to both their past and future experiences.
