Technical Committee Updates:

TC1 – 2: Combustion Instabilities Workshop

The "Dynamics, Monitoring and Control of Combustion Instabilities" initiative is aimed at improving the understanding of flashback, blow out and thermo-acoustic instabilities in lean combustion of "hydrogen blends". This could be achieved via numerical simulation and diagnostics to develop strategies for active control systems. On 7 February 2012, a workshop took place in Rome, Italy to discuss the objectives, goals and timeline of the

newly proposed project. All documents related to the meeting and the initiative can be found on the dedicated Wiki.

TC3 – 4: Filtration Questionnaire

Filtration companies (AAF, Donaldson and Camfil Farr) are developing a <u>Position Paper on Filtration Technology</u>. The objective of this Position Paper is to allow the Users to have a single point of reference for state-of-the-art filtration technology, as well as to establish a framework of metrics to correlate best practice filtration to increase efficiency and reliability.

Project Group Updates:

Exhaust Systems:

The <u>ETN Exhaust Systems PG</u> is making great progress in the formation of an ETN standard for exhaust systems. The group is currently focused on composing a standard for Waste Heat Recovery Units (WHRU), and in the future will also review the API standard on Heat Steam Recovery Generators (HRSG). The standard aims to highlight the possibilities and importance of CFD simulation, using a benchmark case in the appendix of the standard. The merged standard and the CFD validation workplan are to be discussed during the next meeting, kindly hosted by Statoil in Bergen on 15 March 2012.
