
Arriving in Bucharest

Henri Coandă International Airport (Otopeni), the main airport in Bucharest, is located 16 km north of the Bucharest city centre.

Shuttle bus: The Athénée Palace Hilton hotel can be reached from the airport by a shuttle bus, which operates every hour on a daily basis between the airport and the hotel, for a €10 fee per person/one way, by reservation only!

To book the shuttle service please contact the Hilton hotel's Concierge Desk at concierge.bucharest@hilton.com indicating your flight arrival date and time.

Taxi: Licensed taxis at the airport are located at the taxi station situated just outside the terminal. It is also possible to book an authorised taxi via a touchscreen application in the arrivals hall.



Connections Hotel - Workshop venue - Airport
