LM2500 USER GROUP MEETING

ETN's LM2500 User Group meeting was held on 20-21 June 2018 in Berlin where 11 User companies met to discuss the prioritised technical issues with BHGE's technical experts. The Independent Service Providers Cullum Detuners, Gastops, MTU, TransCanada Turbines and VBR Turbine Partners were also invited to join the meeting and present their technology capabilities and service solutions. The Users involved in ETN's Bearing Project held a meeting with BHGE on 19 June ahead of the User meeting to discuss the progress and outcomes of the project.

ASME TURBO EXPO 2018

This year's ASME Turbo Expo took place in Oslo on 11-15 June. ETN participated in the exhibition and co-chaired the Electric Power Committee panel session with EPRI discussing the drivers, needs and requirements of the gas turbine User community. ETIP SNET VISION 2050 REPORT

ETN has been actively involved in the European Technology and Innovation Platform – Smart Networks for Energy Transition (ETIP SNET), which specifies the long term R&D targets for the evolution of the European energy system and brings together the stakeholders and experts from the energy sector. ETN participated in the "Vision 2050" launch event on 27 June 2018 in Brussels where the ETIP SNET Executive Committee and European Commission representatives presented the new ETIP SNET *Vision 2050* publication. The report presents ETIP SNET stakeholders' views for the energy systems of 2050 and provides recommendations for the RD&I framework.
