ETN's 9th International Gas Turbine Conference, held in Brussels on 10-11 October, welcomed 150 participants from over 80 organisations. The compelling need to cut CO₂ emissions and develop carbon neutral energy solutions became key topics of discussion at the conference, as the UN's Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Special Report of Global Warming of 1.5°C was published just before the IGTC. WHITE PAPER ON DIGITALISATION

The objective of ETN's White Paper on Industrial Internet: the next age of productivity for European GT based plants is to provide support and guidance to the ETN members on Industry 4.0 and the Industrial Internet. These topics have been discussed at ETN's Workshops in 2016-2017 during the Technical Committee sessions 4 and 5. The White Paper was drafted by Chris Dagnall (DNV-GL) and Pascal Decoussemaeker (GE Power), based on the input from ETN members, and the full paper was presented last month at our International Gas Turbine Conference.

CEN SFGas Working Group on Gas Quality

The Working Group 'Pre-normative study of H-gas quality parameter' under the CEN Sector for a Gas Infrastructure and Utilisation (CEN SFGas GQS WG) was established in May 2016 with the support of European Commission's DG Energy. The WG studies and evaluates possible WI ranges for distributed H-gas in view of the future revision of EN 16726:2015, and the CEN activities involve all stakeholders, such as TSOs, manufacturers, industrial and automotive. ETN office monitors the updates within the WG and <u>shares information</u> with our members.
