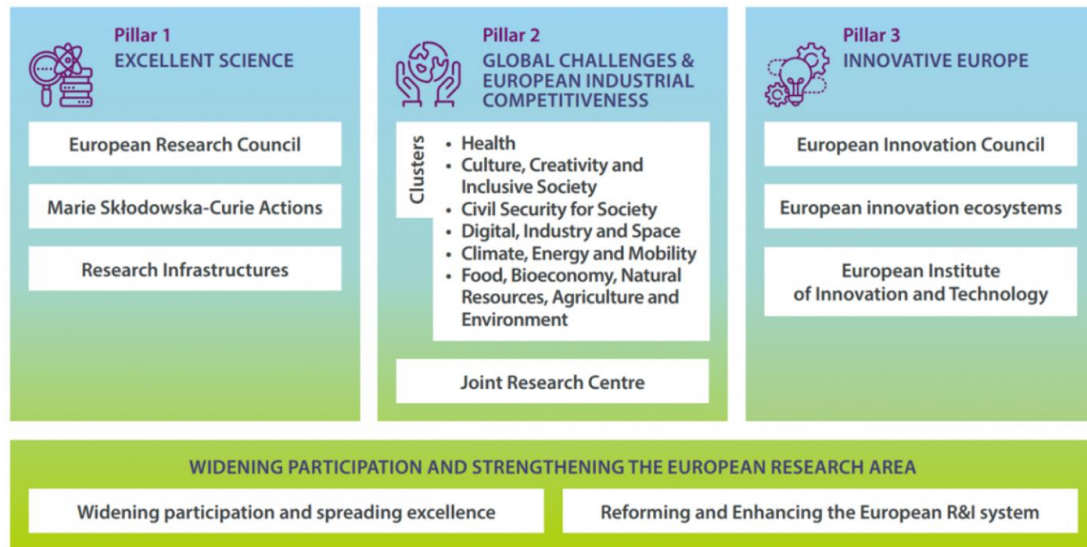

What is Horizon Europe?

- EU's key funding programme for research and innovation
- It has a **budget of €93.5 billion** (C\$ 137 billion) for 2021 – 2027
- It is divided into **three pillars** for implementation




Canada part of Horizon Europe

- Canada became **Associated to Pillar II of Horizon Europe on 3 July 2024**
- Associated membership is the **closest form of cooperation**, giving the Canadian organisations the opportunity to participate on equal terms with their EU counterparts
 - Canadian entities can **join AND lead research consortia**
 - Canadian entities will be **funded directly from the programme**, while Canada will contribute to its budget
