Key Objectives




Develop an independent, knowledgeable and coordinated user community Guide the OEMs, suppliers and service providers to develop and implement new solutions.

How Are User Groups Coordinated?




Formation of New User Groups

1. Specific Engine User-Group Proposal 3. Securing commitment from other end-users


5. ETN Global officially launches the User Group
